Incoming Kindergarten Students:

- Participate in the NIFTY FIFTY CLUB. Read 50 books or have someone read 50 books to you. (complete form http://www.stpeter-deland.org/images/PDF_files/summer_reading/nifty_20fifty_20club.pdf).

Incoming 1st Grade Students:

- Students should choose and read two of the following books:
 - Any Junie B. Jones books by Barbara Park AR 1.5 - 3.0
 - Any Henry and Mudge books by Cynthia Rylant AR 1.5 - 2.7
 - Any Biscuit books by Alyssa Capucilli AR 0.5 - 1.3
- Students should choose one and complete a book report which is due the first day of school
- Students will be expected to take AR tests on these books during the first week of school.

Incoming 2nd Grade Students:

- Read the first "Henry and Mudge and the Careful Cousin" and complete a book report as directed on the school website which is due the first day of school. Student will also take an AR test on this book during the first week.
- Choose one of the following based on reading level and bring a note card with information to take an AR test during the first week of school.
 - Any Judy Moody book by Megan McDonald AR 2.0 - 3.6
 - Any A to Z Mystery book by Ron Roy AR 2.5 - 4.5

Incoming 3rd Grade Students:

- Read Third Grade Angels by Jerry Spinelli AR 2.9 and complete a book report. Book report and AR test due the first day of school.
- Read any TWO of the following titles within personal reading range and take AR Quiz.

 - Any Ramona Quimby book by Beverly Cleary AR 4.8 - 5.6

Incoming 4th Grade Students:

- Read The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane by Kate DiCamillo and complete a book report. Book report is due the first day of school and AR test will be taken during the first week.
- Read any TWO of the following titles within personal reading range and bring notecards to take AR Quizzes.

 - Lost in the Everglades by Carolyn Keene AR 4.3
