Dear Parents:

Your child will need the following supplies this year:

- 1 Book bag (**back packs with wheels are prohibited**)
- 2 Lunch box or bag
- 3 Soft zippered pencil case, (no boxes) with 24 pack yellow #2 pencils, sharpened with student name written on them. **No mechanical pencils**
- 4 Daily planner (**to be purchased from the teacher/ \$4.00**)
- 5 2 packs wide-ruled lined notebook paper (regular ruled)
- 6 6 plastic pocket folders **with prongs**(center clips) in the following colors:

- 12 2 container of wet wipes not baby witpes
- 13 4 boxes of tissues
- 14 2 roll of paper towels
- 15 1- 1 inch 3 ring binder w/pockets for homework book planner (**NO ZIPPER BINDERS**)
- 16 5 composition note books
- 17 2 stretch book covers fo reading and social studies books
- 18 2 reams of white copy paper
- 19 2 boxes storage zippered baggies- 1 sandwich &1 quart size
- 20 (2) 3x5 pack index cards
- 21 large pink erasers and small pencil erasers
- 22 Clear contact paper- please use to cover consumable books- keep at home
- 23 \$9.00 for Seat Sack- you may use your 3rd grade seat sack if it's in good shape
- 24 Earphones or headphones in a ziplock bag with child's name written on it(to be kept in Computer Lab)
- 25 1 pack of 8 ½" x 11" sheet protectors – available at The Dollar Tree
