



Kindergarten Supply List 2026-2027

Please label:

- Regular, simple backpack without a lot of compartments but large enough for papers and art projects.
- Refillable *plastic* water bottle with spout (when metal bottles fall, they are loud and hurt little toes.)
- 1 – Small dry erase board (We use these a lot so look for a quality one that will fit in their lap)
- 1 – Pencil box (The classic hard square kind is recommended. We need something big and easy.)
- 1 – Pair of kid's scissors
- 1 – “Primary manuscript paper pads” aka handwriting notebook (Available at Dollar Tree)
- 2 – sturdy folders with pockets. Please buy one red and one yellow.
- 1 – Pack of pencils (pre-sharpened greatly appreciated)
- Over the ear headphones in Ziplock bag with name written on it (one that doesn’t need charging)
- \$15 for seat sack (in a labeled envelope)

Don’t label: The following are communal supplies that we go through quickly. We have listed the required amounts. *If you are interested in donating extra supplies, these would be greatly appreciated.*

- 3 – Play-Doh containers
- 2 – reams copy paper
- Fine black dry erase markers
- 2 – boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- 2 – boxes of markers
- 2 – packages of baby wipes
- 2 – rolls of paper towels
- 4 – boxes Kleenex
- 1 hand sanitizer
- 1 container Clorox wipes
- Optional: Sharpies, Ziplock bags of various sizes, Boxes of Goldfish or graham crackers, small water bottles/juice or other items for children who forget snacks.

Note: My background is in art education, and I will incorporate art activities throughout the year. If you would like to buy fun art supplies, like interesting markers or colored pencils, please feel welcome! Sometimes supplies are on sale at different times of year. Send it in and I would be excited to help these little Picasso shine! *Tip: Stay away from light-up shoes. If possible, find shoes your child can manipulate themselves (put on, take off, and ideally Velcro/stretch/zip etc. Be sure your child can operate all parts of their lunch supplies independently including carrying, opening and closing all items. All children will need a separate snack each day. It is recommended to place it in a disposable bag so they can distinguish it from their lunch.*
